2019 Sauvignon Blanc

- Composition:** 81% Sauvignon Blanc, 19% Semillon
Harvest: The grapes were hand harvested September 6, 2019.
Brix: 21.0 **Acidity:** 0.62 **pH:** 3.40 **Production:** 674 cases
Fermentation: co-fermented in 100% stainless steel
Organic: All fruit is organically grown in our estate vineyard.

The 2019 Sauvignon Blanc is a field blend of Sauvignon Blanc and Sémillon. The grapes were hand harvested, whole cluster pressed and fermented cold and slow, resulting in a wine with generous volatile aromas and flavors combined with a richly developed palate.

In the glass, the 2019 Sauvignon Blanc is a light straw color. The nose offers abundant aromas of mandarin oranges, lemon blossom, and wet stone. In the mouth, the wine's rich texture and weight are showcased with aromas of green apple, melon, and delicate passionfruit.
